

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Fishing Permitted within the boundaries of Westernport and Port Phillip Bays.

MAJOR PRIZE : DRAWN FROM ALL COMPETITORS

CATEGORIES

Only one category may be entered. Age for Junior categories are as at March 1st 2024.
If no birth date is supplied, the junior will be placed in the TN (Juniors 10 to 15) category.

SM - Senior Male - 16 years or older

SF - Senior Female - 16 years or older

TN - Junior Girl or Boy - 10 to 15 years

JR - Junior Girl or Boy - under 10 years

PLEASE NOTE NEW RULES

• **HEAVIEST FISH ONLY** to be weighed each day.

TEEN AND JUNIOR (TN, JR)

- Heaviest Fish over both days, per Junior category from Heaviest to 5th Heaviest Fish.
- Meritorious Capture by a Junior (VRFish).

SENIOR MALE (SM)

- Heaviest Fish over both days, from Heaviest to 10th Heaviest Fish.

SENIOR FEMALE (SF)

- Heaviest Fish over both days, from Heaviest to 5th Heaviest Fish.

COMBINED:

- Boat, Motor & Trailer to be drawn from ALL Registered Competitors.
- Heaviest Whiting for Challenge - (will be excluded from Category Heaviest Fish Prize) wins an Original painting of a Whiting by Bridgit Thomas.
- First 1.0 kg or greater Whiting Weighed in. - Prize \$1000 from **Fishing Online Hastings**.

FISHING RULES - JUNIORS

- Any fish weighed in by a Junior Competitor is eligible for a prize in the Junior Categories and Combined Categories.
- Any fish weighed in by a Junior is INELIGIBLE for the Senior Categories.
- Junior Competitors may present their heaviest King George Whiting, which must be 27cm or greater in length.

FISHING RULES - SENIORS

- Senior Competitors may present their heaviest King George Whiting, which must be 30cm or greater in length.
- Any fish weighed in by a Senior Competitor is INELIGIBLE for the Junior Categories of the Competition.

GENERAL RULES AND WEIGH-IN

- Fishing Guides or Charter Operators & immediate family members are NOT eligible to enter this Amateur Event. This does not preclude competitors fishing on a Charter or with a Guide.
- Each Competitor must hook, fight & land their own fish.
- All Fisheries regulations must be adhered to.
- Competitors must fish within the boundaries of Westernport and Port Phillip Bays.
- The Weigh Station will be at the Westernport Angling Club building adjacent to the Hastings Boat Ramp.
- Competitors must be at the Weigh Station by the deadline designated in this entry form.
- Fish presented after the deadline time will not be weighed.
- The weight of the anglers selected heaviest fish ONLY will be weighed EACH DAY.
- Fish are to be weighed whole. Mutilated fish will not be accepted. The Challenge Committee reserves the right to open any fish for inspection.
- The Challenge Committee reserves the right to inspect any equipment / boats used by competitors.
- Any boats found to contain illegal equipment will cause all competitors who used the boat to be disqualified.
- Any Angler found to be in breach of the Competition rules will be disqualified.
- Any protest must be in writing and lodged with the Weigh Station no later than 3 minutes after the deadline for the weigh-in close on the day of the fish being caught.
- All Challenge Committee decisions are final.
- In the case of a tied weight, the first fish weighed will be determined the winner.
- The Boat, Outboard Motor & Trailer shall be drawn from all competitors.
To claim the prize, the valid Competitors Card matching the drawn competitor number must be presented within 5 minutes of the draw to claim the prize; otherwise a redraw will occur every 5 minutes until the prize is claimed.
- The Boat, Motor and Trailer will become the property of the Competitor registered against the Competitor number, not the presenter of the valid Competitor Card.
