WEIGHMASTER REPORT - Patric Neidhart

Hi all members, quick update re the last couple of comps,

BEMM RIVER :

well the comp weekend was a great success for all of us with kind weather and fantastic fishing with some of the best captures in 10 years with quality and quantity.

The quality of the fishing made it a close event with 200grams between 1st and 2nd and 30 grams between 2nd and 3rd and 300 grams to 4th and 5th places for anglers best 5 fish each day for the total of 10 for the comp.

We had around 11 fish weighed in at the 1kg mark with 3 of them over 1.2kg which is the biggest number of big bream I have personally seen in this comp from thousands of bream caught weighed and or released in over the years on this trip.

We also managed to snag a few other varieties of species with tailor, salmon, trevally, flathead and ludrick amongst some of the catches making the trip interesting for all involved.

Results: a total of 29 competitors for the event with 182 fish weighed in for the event for the capped 10 fish two day bag.
